V. Project Reports

A. NRCS Programs

1. District Conservationist Report – None provided at this time.

- **B.** KCCD 2024 Election- Anna reported that the final ballot count was completed on March 19th. No additional ballots were received in the mail after election day. The EF2 form was submitted to the Commission as required.
- **C. Financial Report -** Schedule 22 review was completed earlier this week, and a draft of the Annual Report will be available at the next board meeting.
- **D.** Review of RCW 89.08.210 and 220 All individuals attending the meeting reviewed the RCWs together.
- E. City of Ellensburg Meeting Anna met with Jon Morrow from the City of Ellensburg about their Gateway Project on Vantage Highway. They are looking for assistance with a potential fish screen project on east branch Lyle Creek. Anna will be attending a meeting with the project team and then a meeting with City staff, where she will share information on joining the conservation district at the request of Jon.

VI. Action Items

A. City of Roslyn Interlocal

1. Task Orders 01 and 02 for Chipping and CWDG

Anna reviewed the 2020 agreement with the City of Roslyn and found that the agreement needed updating for future chipping programs and the CWDG grant. She drafted a new agreement and two task orders: one for the chipping work through 06-30-2025 and another for the CWDG grant work. The Roslyn City Council has reviewed and approved the new agreement and task orders.

B. Yakima Tributary Access & Habitat Program

1. Coleman 4.4 Project Completion

The Coleman Creek 4.4 project is substantially complete. The final costs have been submitted. Only 40% of the force account for site restoration was charged. A little under half of the approved amount for Change Order 2 (overtime, heating structure, etc.) was charged.

The DNR Landscape Scale Restoration (LSR) Project adjacent to Ronald will use this contract, along with CWDG. The LSR project will likely be first as the project site identified and DNR is working on a portion of it.

1. Okanogan CD

In review of the remaining funds for this grant and talking with the other Districts in the cluster, Okanogan CD has identified a need for \$56,200 to cover a gap in funding for a canal project survey.

2. Vehicle Replacement

Anna reported that it may be possible for the PE grant to replace the Ford F150, which was purchased by the PE grant in 2012. If a justification can be provided along with an update as to the status of the Engineer position, the Commission may allow a vehicle purchase. At this time, there is enough funding projected to be left to do that. Anna has talked with Kelleher Motors about the piggybacking option again to replace the truck for another F150. The priority is to ensure all district partners have their engineering needs met, then if funding is still available to consider a purchase.
